You won't want to miss this 11-day immersive journey from Zagreb to Dubrovnik, which combines cultural exploration, natural wonders, and coastal cruising.

The adventure begins with guided tours of Zagreb and the Dalmatian countryside, including visits to Krka National Park's waterfalls and Šibenik's UNESCO-listed cathedral. Midway, travelers board the MS Desire, a premium, luxury small ship, to explore coastal gems like Trogir, Split, and the islands of Hvar, Vis, and Korčula. Highlights include visiting the Blue Cave, walking through medieval towns, swimming at famed beaches, and savoring traditional Dalmatian cuisine.
