What is Student Self Service and how do I gain access to it?

Student Self Service (mcis.meredith.edu) allows students to view account activity by term. Students can access Student Self Service once they have been assigned a NET ID and password from Technology Services and have registered for classes.

Where can I view and pay my bill?

Log in to your Student Self Service, click on the Financial Information tab, and then click on Make a Payment – PayMyTuition. You will be redirected to **PayMyTuition.com.** Here, you will be able to view your bill, make a payment, and enroll in a payment plan.

What is PayMyTuition?

Meredith College has partnered with PayMyTuition, a payment processing platform. Here, you can view your billing statements and account activity, set up an authorized user(s), make payments, and enroll in a payment plan. With PayMyTuition, you can pay from any bank, in any country, and in any currency.

When will my bill be available online?

The fall semester bill will be available online through Student Self Service/PayMyTuition on or around **July 5.** Students who pre-register for the spring semester will be able to view the billing statement on or before **November 10.** If you register after these dates, your billing statement will be available within the next business day following registration.

What are the tuition due dates for pre-registered students?

Students are billed by semester.

- Fall bills are due August 1.
- Spring bills are due December 1.

Why am I being charged for medical insurance on my bill?

All students must enroll in Meredith's BCBS insurance or **opt out by completing a waiver** with their personal insurance information. Please visit **meredith.edu/health-services** for information on how to waive medical insurance.

What payment methods are available?

- Debit/Credit card: access online through Student Self Service (convenience fee applies) Cards are currently not accepted in the Accounting Office.
- ACH/bank draft: access online through Student Self Service (no fee to pay via ACH/bank draft).

Please be sure to include the Student ID number on the check.

How can I make an online payment to the student account without access to Student Self Service?

You can make an online payment to the student account through **officialpayments.com.** There is no log in required. You only need the student's name, ID#, and the amount you wish to pay. You can use a Debit/Credit card (convenience fee applies) or ACH/bank draft (no fee) to pay.

What payment plans do you offer?

In order to allow you to divide your semester bill into monthly installments, we offer an interest-free payment plan. A non-refundable fee of \$35 is due upon enrollment in the plan. Students must re-enroll each semester.

Semester	Payment Due Dates	Deadline to Enroll
FALL 4 MONTH	Payments are due on the first of each month August through November	August 31
FALL 5 MONTH	Payments are due on the first of each month July through November	August 31
SPRING 4 MONTH	Payments are due on the first of each month January through April	January 31
SPRING 5 MONTH	Payments are due on the first of each month December through April	January 31

FAQs CONTINUED

Will I receive a physical bill?

No, the Accounting Department does not send physical bills. View your bill online through the Student Self Service/PayMyTuition portal.

I'm an international student. Can I pay my bill on PayMyTuition?

Yes. International students can also access PayMyTuition through Student Self Service. You'll have the option to pay from an international bank, institution, or card. Additionally, you can pay in any currency and enroll in a payment plan.

I need assistance navigating PayMyTuition. Who can I contact?



STEP 2: Register for an Account with PayMyTuition



ADDING AN AUTHORIZED USER


An authorized user is someone who logs in on behalf of a student to view the student's data or perform an action on their behalf. For example, a mother may wish to view or pay her daughter's tuition. *Note: Authorized users do not have access to tax documents.

A student must grant a family member or third-party authorized user access through their **PayMyTuition portal.** Below are the instructions on how students can add an authorized user.


STEP 1: Add an Authorized User

Log in to your Student Self Service portal at mcis.meredith.edu and navigate to the PayMyTuition portal.

Select the "My Profile" section and click "Add authorized users to your account."



You can track the status of your authorized user request, edit authorized user details, delete the authorized user from your account, and resend the email link for registration within your **Authorized users list dashboard.** You may add as many authorized users as you need.




AUTHORIZED USER INSTRUCTIONS

Below are instructions for authorized users to register an account.


STEP 1: Complete Your Profile Registration

Once your student adds you as an authorized user, you will receive an email from PayMyTuition with a request to register for an account. Click on the link within the email to complete your account setup.



STEP 2: Access Your PayMyTuition Account as an Authorized User

To access your student's PayMyTuition account as an Authorized User, log in at the **PayMyTuition portal.**




Input your email address and password and click "Login" to access the student's Payment Center to make a payment.








From the Payment Center page, select "Make Payment."





Select the term(s) and enter the amount you would like to pay. Then click "Pay Now."




Follow the prompts to enter payment information, confirm, and pay.


Meredith College has partnered with **PayMyTuition** to offer an interest-free Payment Plan to enable students or their families to make monthly installments on their student account towards tuition, fees, and food and housing. **The payment plan is not a loan and is available for the fall and spring semesters for four or five automatic installments per semester.** Enrolling in a plan requires a **non-refundable \$35 fee** and **students must re-enroll each semester.**



STEP 2: Check for Eligibility

Once you are redirected to the **PayMyTuition portal**, you will see **"Enroll in Payment Plan"** if you are eligible to enroll. Click on this option to begin the enrollment process.

If the "Enroll in Payment Plan" option isn't visible, contact Meredith College Accounting Office at accounting@meredith.edu or call (919) 760-8363 to inquire about eligibility.


STEP 3:


Select the term(s)

for which you want to enroll in a payment plan. From there, you will be prompted to **confirm the plan details.**

Review the plan balance and click on "Calculate."

Review the payment installment schedule, select installment(s) you want to pay now, then click "Next."





For international students, a pop up will appear after you select "Make Payment."

Select domestic payment or international.

Then select "Pay Now."



STEP 4:

Select your payment method and enter payment information.

Then agree to the Terms and Conditions to finalize your plan and make your payment.

Please note: You will be able to access a detailed breakdown of charges and see your existing balance before enrolling. Make sure you are fully informed of all expenses before finalizing your plan.
